

#### **BETHANY**

When Mother Mary (previously Sister Martha) and the Bethany orphans were in need, you answered! In 2018, you helped fund a new passenger van for the orphanage, collecting an amazing \$40k. Your generosity made it possible for Mother Mary to buy not only the passenger van but to also have a surplus, which they've used for food, clothing, and medical bills. Most importantly, you've given the orphaned girls of Bethany happiness. In this van they can attend Church services at other monasteries, and even go on outings, to places like the beach, where they have the freedom to just be kids and play. Your donations will continue giving them joy for years to come!



#### **BALI**

This year your donations to Bali were literally life-saving! In April, Fr. Alexander Kosebi's sixteen-year-old daughter was in a moped accident, driving home from school. During this accident Mary Grace injured her face, foot, and hand. To have Mary's injuries treated Fr. Alexander had to take a loan from his friends to get Mary Grace necessary treatment, including stitches and a three-day hospital stay.

Two months later Mary Grace developed a huge bump on her head and frequently suffered from nausea and dizziness. Without the necessary funds, Mary Grace could not receive a CT scan to check for post-traumatic bleeding, which is a life threatening diagnosis. Fr. Alexander reached out to you with a request for \$450, to save his daughter. You answered with \$7,000 which provided Mary Grace with a CT scan and two months of outpatient treatment, to heal her inner left brain injury. Additional funds have been used to support the family and mission church. Thank you for giving Mary Grace access to lifesaving treatment and a healthy future!



#### HAITI


The past few years have been truly tragic for the Haiti mission. Over the course of 10 years Haiti has experienced widespread flooding, fierce tropical storms, a magnitude-7 earthquake, and then, finally, the sad death of Fr. Gregoire. In the wake of this tragedy you've given our Orthodox brothers and sisters something exceptionally valuable: hope. This year the FFA partnered with the Orthodox Mission of Haiti to sponsor the "Congress of Work," program which included included rudimentary training in computer science, photography, communication, and even liturgics. Through this course, 15 participants were able to gain valuable practical skills that they can use to support themselves financially, while also learning how to testify to the world about their seemingly insurmountable obstacles. You've made it possible for the people of Haiti to empower themselves and lay the foundation for financial stability for generations to come.

# OUR CLERGY NEEDED YOUR ASSISTANCE TO CONTINUE SERVING OUR CHURCH

#### HOLY TRINITY SEMINARY: MASTERS IN DIVINITY

This fall, Holy Trinity Seminary unveiled a new Master's program of Divinity to insure that our priests are prepared to face the challenges of the 21st century. We asked you to help support this worthy cause by contributing \$20,000 dollars towards instituting the Prince Vladimir Galitzine Scholarship, in honor of our organization's long-term president who passed away in March.

You responded by pledging enough funds to make it possible for Fr. Foti Edman to attend graduate school and become a better prepared priest. Fr. Foti hadn't even thought about attending graduate school but when he heard that there was one more scholarship available he applied and with Metropolitan Hilarion's blessing began attending graduate school in Fall 2018. You've given Fr. Foti a gift that he will continue giving back to our Church.

#### JORDANVILLE SUMMER BOYS: FROM SUMMER BOYS TO WINTER MEN

Last summer, 20 young men participated in Holy Trinity Monastery's Summer Youth Program. Over the course of three weeks, the 20 Summer Boys experienced the richness of both Monastery and Seminary life through worship, learning, work and prayer. They participated in beautiful Monastery services, high-level discussion led by Seminary faculty and guest speakers, skilled and unskilled monastery obediences, and recreational activities. This years' participants were so enthusiastic and helpful that the brotherhood anticipated their return to the monastery with joy.

Over the years, the Summer Youth Program has continued to make a lasting impact on the lives of our youth. When leaving the program participants go home with a deeper relationship with God and friendships forged in faith. Most recently, in the fall of 2018, three former participants entered the Holy Trinity Seminary. You've made it possible for our youth to continue to stay strong in their faith and become closer to the Church.



#### ST. HERMAN'S YOUTH CONFERENCE-WEST

The Parish of St. Elias hosted the 2018 St. Herman's West Youth Conference, in Placerville, CA. This spiritual retreat was attended by 49 youths, including 11 youth counselors and 8 clergy members. Fr. Moses Berry gave a wonderful lecture on "Where your treasure is, your heart will be also," a theme that connected the spiritual life to the mining history of the area. In addition to listening to other lectures, the youths participated in workshops that developed church reading and singing skills. Afterwards, our youth performed a good deed, visiting the elderly and raising their spirits by singing joyous carols.

This year's conference was unique because we added an extra day to the schedule, which allowed the youth to also pilgrimage to liturgy at the Serbian Church in Jackson. There the youths were able to venerate the relics of St. Sebastian. After attending liturgy the youth went panning for gold and explored local caves. All of this and more was made possible by your support! You made it possible to keep the registration fee low enough so our youth could afford to enrich their souls in the light of Christ.
