
## <u>Fund for Assistance to the</u> <u>Russian Orthodox Church Outside of Russia</u>

Dear name,

I just wanted to drop a few lines to tell you what's been going on in our Church – thanks to kindhearted people like you. Just so you know, I'm not sending this letter to everyone – just you and a few other most loyal friends. People who absolutely love our Church.

First of all... let me say thank you.

This year, your gift was especially important. Let me tell you what you have done for:

## The Holy Protection Skete

I'm absolutely thrilled that you and other lovely donors allowed us to help our own dear First Hierarch, **Metropolitan Hilarion**! This was the <u>first time</u> in <u>our history</u> that a First Hierarch asked for help – for something that even remotely relates to *himself*.

Usually, it's: "Dear FFA, can you ask your amazing donors to help this person? He really-really needs you...".

But this time you and I were privileged to help Vladyka himself by giving to the Holy Protection Skete in Buena, NJ. Vladyka actually spends time there. So **you helped** *him* **personally**, even though your donation to the skete will end up benefiting so many other people who will come to pray there!

By the way, did you know that your name is being commemorated there by Abbot Fr Tikhon, and the Metropolitan himself?

But here are some tangible things you've brought about: Fr Tikhon Gayfudinov, Vladyka's cell attendant and the abbot of the Skete, now has a tractor! This means that Fr. Tikhon can dig graves at the skete cemetery. And that means that the skete now has a new source of income! Which is another step in making the skete self-sufficient. That's a huge win!

The tractor is also saving Fr. Tikhon countless hours of work. Small jobs like moving 30 tree stumps used to take him a whole day. Now he can do it in an hour. Before the tractor is would take him a week to plant 30 trees - now he does it one day. Glory to God for all things!

So far, we've collected over a good amount for the skete and we have over 40 monthly donors who are being commemorated at every service.
